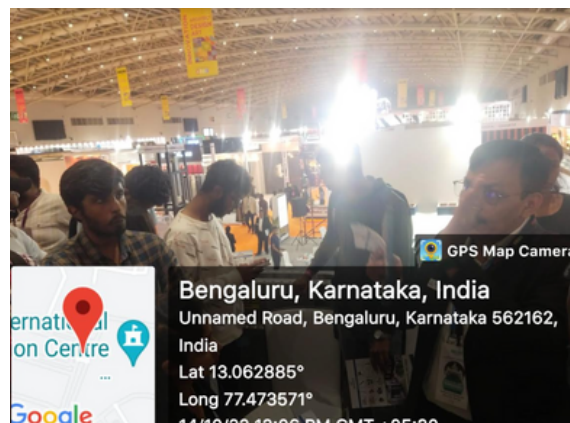


Exchanging sweets is a part of the celebration. Sweets are exchanged to mark the festival and express love to family and close ones.

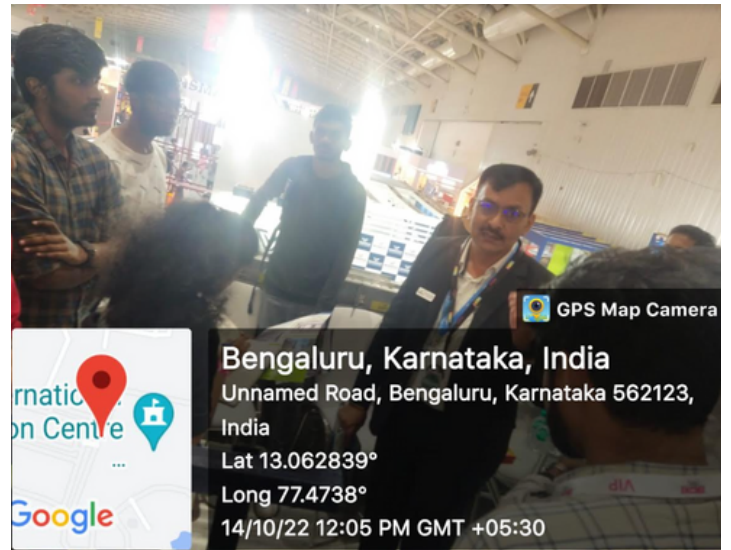
