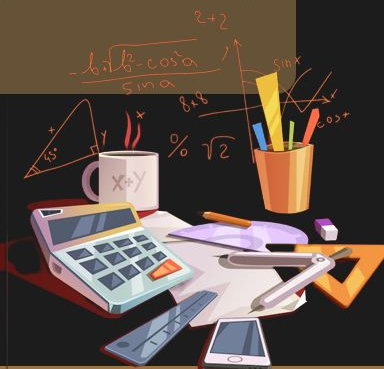
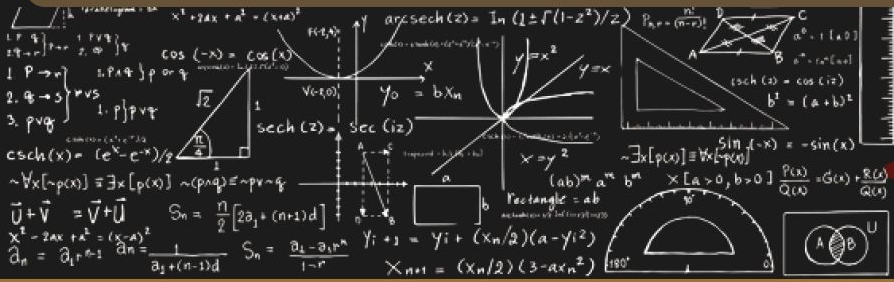
Project Description
