

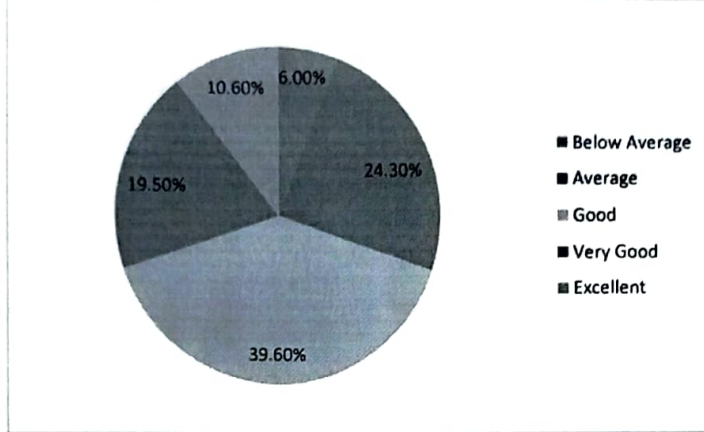

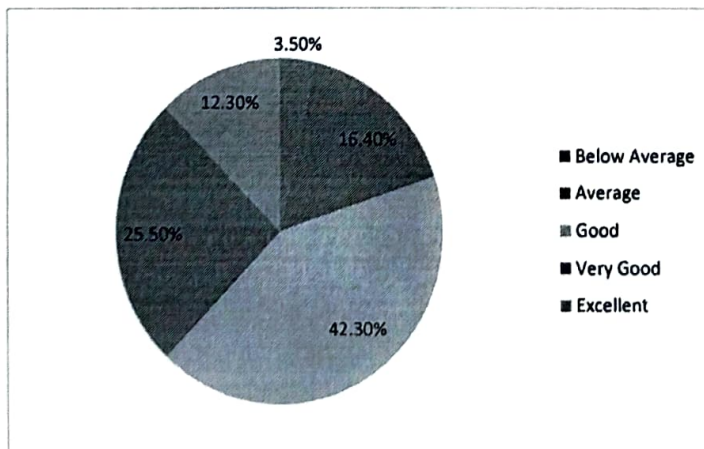
Content of syllabi of the course

Extent of syllabi covered in the class

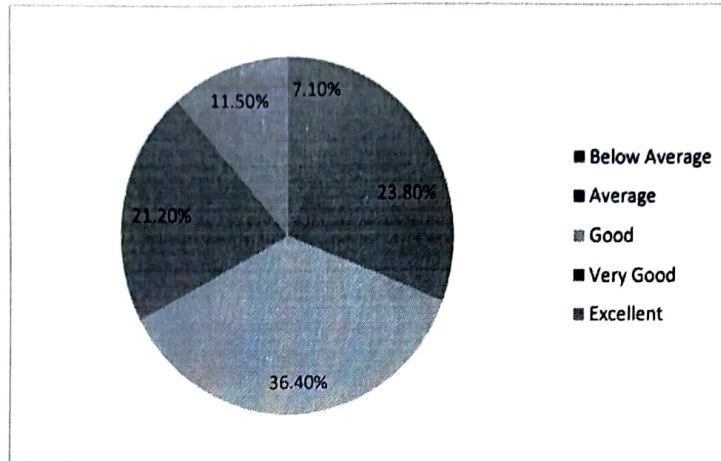

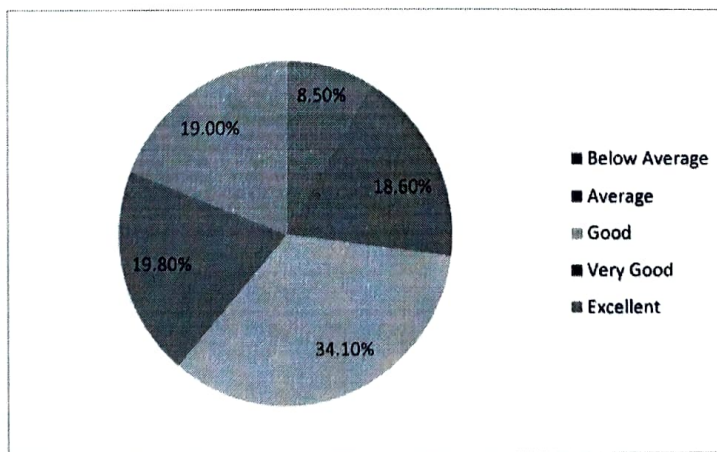

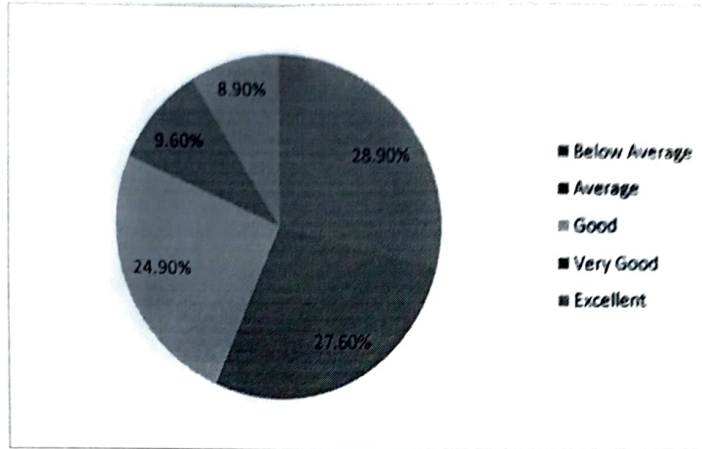

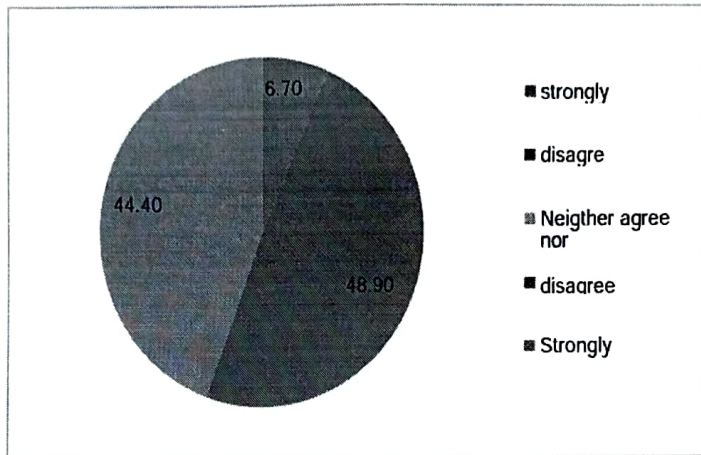

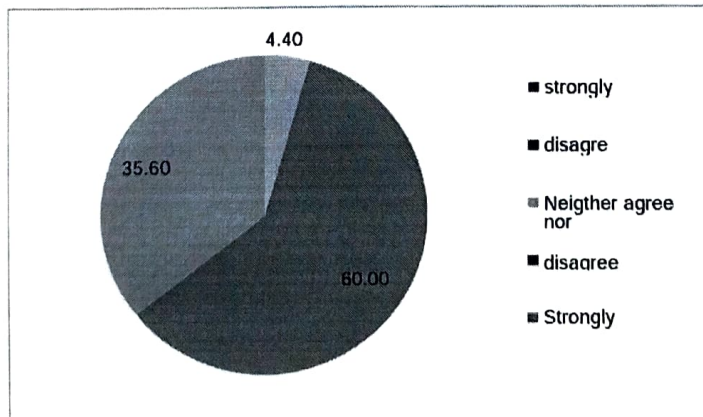

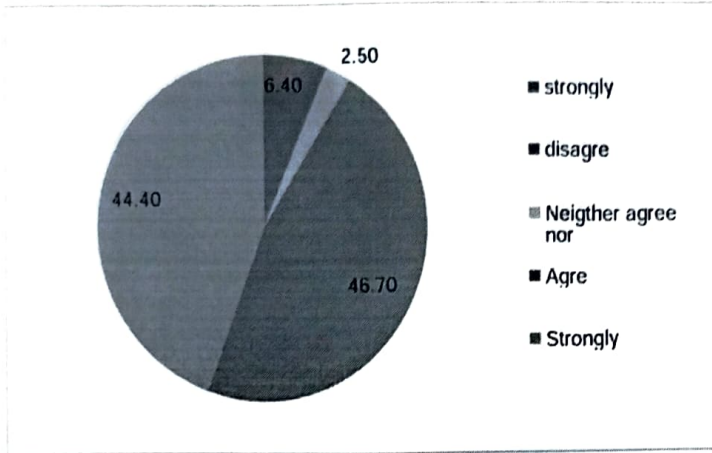

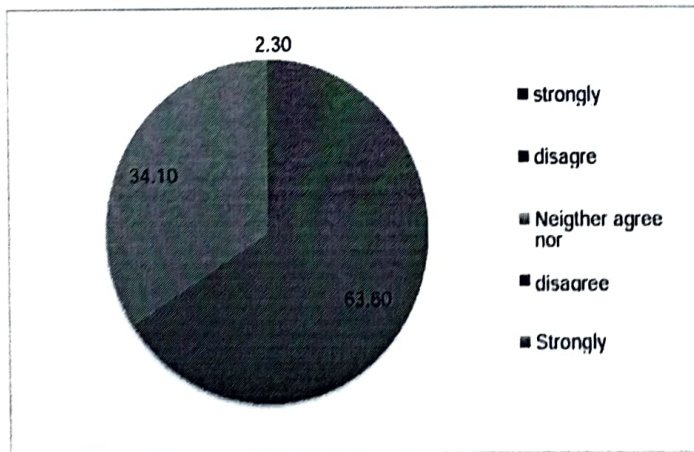
