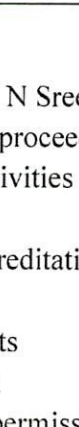

Proceedings:

1. Dr. T N Sreenivasa, Principal, Atria Institute of Technology greeted all the members present online & offline and welcomed each one of them.
2. The proceedings of the Governing Council Meeting held on 10th Jan. 2022 was reviewed and **action taken** are as under:
 - a. The number of research scholars is increasing at the Institute level as presented by the Principal.
 - b. Efforts are being made to improve the quality of intake; this will be apparent after the next admission cycle (2022 intake).
 - c. The Placement officer has made the list of companies not visited the institution as per the suggestions given by the GC members. Some of the companies have confirmed the visit to Atria.
 - d. The Institution will plan for Autonomous status after the NAAC Accreditation with a minimum of "A" grade.
 - e. Atria I T has moved from Band Beginner to Band Promising status in ARIIA (ATAL Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements) Ranking.
 - f. To improve the quality of publication, the Institution has implemented incentive scheme to motivate the faculty members and the Research dean is addressing the faculty department wise to create awareness.
 - g. The SWOC analysis of various programs were reviewed and finalized with the assistance of Dr. Balaveera Reddy and the same is uploaded on website.
 - h. The ABET accreditation can be considered after Atria gets NIRF ranking within 100.
3. The Principal presented the activities at the Institution level for the last four months, January to April 2022.
4. The Principal informed that we are striving to get good marks in NBA accreditation, the visit is due in June 2022, the date is yet to be confirmed. We have parallely started looking at the requirements of 2nd cycle NAAC accreditation.
5. The GC members appreciated the efforts of the stake holders and congratulated them.
6. The members commented on the 18th Graduation Day celebrated on 9th April 2022 in a grand scale, they said such activities will definitely brand the institution and take it to the next level.
7. The members felt that the Teaching-Learning should be given more importance as the graduated numbers compared to the admitted numbers is quite less as presented in the graduated data.

8. It is decided to implement the scholarship scheme, where the candidates with less than or equal to 5000 ranking will get 100% tuition fee waive off and the students with greater than 5000 up to 10,000 will get 50% tuition fee waive off while joining the Institution.
9. The Council felt that the Placement is fairly improved; efforts to be made to increase the number of students with higher package.
10. Dr. Mohan felt that the progress in Research is very slow; He asked Dean Research to motivate and drive the faculty to produce a greater number of quality publications (Q1 and Q2) and write proposals for funded projects, also improve consultancy.
11. Based on the recommendation of the Research committee, Seed Money of rupees one Lakh per Researcher is approved by the GC to spend on Research.
12. The highlights provided by GC members were:
 - a) Provide more emphasis for Research activities.
 - b) Give more prominence for Teaching-Learning.
 - c) Attract companies providing higher packages for placements.
 - d) Attempt to enroll better ranking students.
