Proceedings:

1. Dr. T N Sreenivasa, Principal, Atria Institute of Technology greeted all the members present online & offline and welcomed each one of them.
2. The proceedings of the Governing Council Meeting held on 27th August 2022 was reviewed and **action taken** are as under:
 - a. The IUCEE Teaching-Learning Centre and Student Chapter is inaugurated. The faculty members are trained in active learning methods and are executed through the Quiklrm platform. The faculty members are informed to break the class-session every 15 to 20 minutes and conduct short activities like Poll, Think-Pair-Share, quiz, Crossword, Hangman, Millionaire, Snakes and Ladders, and other similar gamified activities.
 - b. An MoU is signed with ComedKares launched by COMEDK (Consortium of Medical, Engineering and Dental Colleges of Karnataka) to help Engineering Students Stay up to date on new and emerging technology skills. They have established 8 advanced skill centres and each skill centre plans to support 10 to 12 member institutions. First year students of 2021-22 batch are undergoing internship in Yelahanka branch.
 - c. The VTU curriculum of 2022-23 batch is in line with NEP 2020, the faculty handling first year have undergone training conducted by VTU in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics which is application based specific to different programs. The internship for four weeks starts right from first year. Most of the higher semester courses are skill based.
 - d. To improve the quality of publication, the Institution has implemented incentive scheme to motivate the faculty members to spend quality time on research.
 - e. To achieve Band Performer status in ARIIA (ATAL Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements) Ranking, the schedule released by IIC (Institution's Innovation Council) is distributed among different departments, the activities are planned and executed. This IIC portal is directly linked to ARIIA portal. As of now we have one star for one quarter of 2021-22 (March 2022-Aug.2022). The next year for IIC starts from Sept. 2022 to Aug. 2023, first quarter activities are uploaded.
3. The Principal presented the activities at the Institution level for the last four months. Subsequently, the HoDs spoke about the achievements of their respective departments. The activities conducted and the ERP (Quiklrm – Optymis) usage for e-governance (paperless administration and implementation of OBE) was appreciated by the members.

4. The performance of the each of the departments were analyzed by GC members and provided suggestions for improvement.
5. The admission status is compared for the last five years and there is an upward trend as seen below.



6. The Principal proposed the increase in intake for the academic year 2023-24 in view of the NBA accreditation for the following branches; CSE and ISE- from 120 to 180, CSE (Data Science) – from 60 to 120. The members approved the proposal. The Governing council also approved to start a new program in emerging areas in Artificial Intelligence and Machine learning.
7. The GC ratified the deputation of Dr. T N Sreenivasa, the Principal, as the Registrar (Evaluation) to the Visvesvaraya Technological University for a period of 2 years or until further orders from 19th Dec. 2022. The same has been approved by the Trust on 15th Dec.2022.
8. The Principal said that Dr. Raj Acharya has submitted his willingness to detach from Governing Council of Atria Institute of Technology due to his extended engagement. The Committee accepted his resignation and authorized the Chairman, Shri. C S Raju to replace a suitable person before next GC meeting.
9. The following actions are initiated to improve NIRF ranking:
 - a. Faculty are being recruited to improve the SFR.
 - b. Library is automated, number of volumes/titles are increased as per the requirement.
 - c. The number of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities is being improved.
 - d. The Research activities are being guided by Dr. S Mohan (GC member) and the Research dean, Seed money is being provided to the Researchers to carry out the Research projects, Incentive is provided for quality paper publications.
 - e. Assistance is provided to students to take up competitive exams for higher studies (GATE, TOFEL, GRE etc.).
 - f. Attempts are made to get a greater number of core companies, improve placements and improve the average salary.
 - g. The number of outreach and extension activities are being improved.

- h. To improve perception various means of branding is adopted through social media, alumni and parents.
10. The Department of MBA has been assessed by Business World under category of Top Business Management Institutions of India. The department is ranked 112 in National level and 38 under Region wise Private - South region Best B- School in Nov. 2022.
 11. The GC members remarked that, CSE being the most wanted branch across the country, higher ranking students join the program, it is important to take the department to the next level in terms of University ranks, Collaborative activities and Research.
 12. The members felt that the department of ISE should also proceed on the same lines, as it is an IT branch.
 13. GC members felt that ECE department is good at conducting a greater number of activities, SDP and FDP. They have to improve the number of quality publications and Research grants.
 14. GC members opined that extra efforts are required from the department of Mechanical Engineering to place the students. This will motivate the students to spread the message to their contacts, which in turn may increase the admission. Also, efforts should be made to take personal attention on each student, mentor them and help them to get good grade as normally slow learners are more in number in the department of ME.
 15. The Council felt that the department of Civil Engineering is performing well in terms of quality publications, Research grants and consultancy. However, efforts to be made to brand the department in terms of placement and result, so that admission can be improved.
 16. The department of Basic Science Engineering & Humanities was complemented by the members as they have performed well in both Academics and Research.
 17. NCC- The Management approved to build NCC firing range (25 mts.) at Atria as soon as we applied for NCC Unit at our campus. It is built within a week and is located 6 KMs from Head Quarters of Karnataka and Goa Directorate and is located in the heart of Bangalore City. The NCC 3 KAR camp is successfully conducted at Atria Institute of Technology from 24th to 31st Oct.2022, the Principal, Dr. T N Sreenivasa and Dr. Nalinakshi N, BSE HoD were felicitated for their excellent support during the sequence of programs of the camp on the valedictory session on 30th Oct. 2022. Subsequently, The NCC unit for Atria under 3 KAR is approved for 80 Cadets. 50 Cadets are selected under the Atria NCC unit out of 84 students for training.
 18. The Principal said that Formative feedback and Summative feedback are administered every semester and actions are initiated in case of any problems. Also, 360 degree feedback is taken on all the heads and Principal, both by the students and staff members. This is analyzed and counselled wherever required.
 19. The highlights of the concluding remarks by the GC members were:
 - a) Identify the right resource to drive Research activities.
 - b) Discover alternate plan for higher Research funding.
 - c) Increase the number of doctorates by recruiting dedicated faculty to produce quality publications and Research grants.
 - d) Concentrate on attributes required to improve the NIRF and ATAL ranking.
 - e) Adopt student-friendly method of Teaching-Learning process.
 20. The Principal said that the three rounds of internal and two rounds of external review of NAAC SSR (Self Study Report) is completed. The fine tuning of the data upload is in process. The SSR will be submitted on or before 30th Dec. 2022 on NAAC portal.
 21. The budget for the ensuing academic year 2022-23 was approved.
